Non-affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • The Firm does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.			
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. • The Firm does not jointly market.
